FY23 HDS ANNUAL SUSTAINABILITY REPORT

Environmental Eats events encourages more sustainable food choices and showcases how small choices can have large impact on food systems. This year, we engaged more than 350 students on topics such as food justice, nutrition, protein alternatives, and honey!

The **Zero Waste Game** is a campaign in the residence halls and Aggie Village Apartments that educate students about proper waste disposal at CSU. In Spring 2023, an average of 22% of all residents participated in the interactive, online, game.

The **Sustainable Living Challenge** is a health-focused campaign, specifically designed for our apartment communities, which fosters sustainable behavior choices in our homes. Approximately 1 in 3 Aggie Family Apartments engaged with resident champions for a healthier living space.

The annual residential move-out donation program, **Pack It, Store It, Donate It**, collects gently-used clothing and homegoods to give back to the Fort Collins community. In May 2023, we donated over 17,000 pounds of materials to five non-profits and organizations in Fort Collins.

Over 100 people participated in the annual **Compost Giveaway and E-Waste Collection**, which offers free compost to the CSU community for their gardening needs and the opportunity to recycle electronic waste at no cost.

Almost ten years since the last sustainable building renovation certification, Braiden Hall received a **Gold LEED Certification**, a measure and recognition for healthy, efficient, and carbon and cost-saving sustainable buildings.

The Spoke celebrated its 5th birthday! This student-run and student-funded bike shop offers thousands of educational interactions to the CSU community each year.
